



### **Advisory**

While advisory groups have been a part of the MMA student experience for years, we are continuing to enhance the existing advisory program. Each student will have an advisor who will get to know her and support her throughout her four years at Merion. Students will meet with their advisor and in their advisory groups on a weekly basis. Advisors will help students navigate through their high school years and ensure that students' learning needs are met. They will encourage students to make good academic choices and will help them plan for their future. Parents/caregivers are encouraged to contact their daughter's advisor with questions about academic progress, extracurricular opportunities, and course selection.

### **Co-Curricular Time**

Two weekly co-curricular periods maximize the opportunities students have to engage in various clubs and affinity groups during the school day. During orientation week, students will attend the Activities Fair in order to learn about the clubs and activities available to them. Following the Activities Fair, students will be encouraged to sign up for those activities they feel most passionate about.
